

D. Terms of the Scholarship Award

An awardee shall:

- ◆ enroll the required academic load in the identified training institution.
- ◆ enter into a Scholarship Contract between himself/herself, the Sending Institution, SEI-DOST and the Training Institution, and comply with the terms and conditions.

After signing the Scholarship Contract, the scholar's name shall be included in the list of scholars needing clearance from DOST-SEI forwarded to the National Bureau of Investigation.

- ◆ maintain the grade requirement in the graduate program and comply with all other academic requirements of the Training Institution.
- ◆ render return service to the Sending Institution, upon completion of his/her PhD degree, on full-time basis along his/her field of specialization for a minimum period equivalent to the length of time he/she enjoyed the scholarship.



Capacity Building Program in Science Education



The Department of Science and Technology-Science Education Institute shall award a 3 or 6-year scholarship grant to qualified science and mathematics faculty of Teacher Education Institutions (TEI) to pursue a PhD in Science/Mathematics Education degree with major in any of the following priority fields of specialization:

- ◆ Biology
- ◆ Chemistry
- ◆ Physics
- ◆ Mathematics

Objectives of the Program

The program aims to :

- ◆ improve the quality of science/mathematics education in the country;
- ◆ increase the number and improve the quality of faculty in the Teacher Education Institutions; and
- ◆ develop and produce competent educators, policy makers, researchers, administrators and other educational personnel involved in science and mathematics education.

A. Criteria of Eligibility

The applicant must:

1. have been a scholar-graduate under any of the DOST-SEI scholarship programs in the undergraduate or master's levels; and/or have graduated with academic honors in the undergraduate degree or have master's degree in any of the priority fields;
2. be a science or mathematics faculty of a Teacher Education Institutions (TEI's) with permanent status;
3. not be more than 45 years old at the time of application;
4. have passed the doctoral admission test in science / mathematics education in any of the identified institutions;
5. not be a recipient of other scholarships;
6. be recommended by the Head of the Sending Institution;
7. be allowed (by the Sending Institution) to study full-time for 3 years (Residential Mode) and part-time for 6 years (Distance Education Mode) ;
8. possess sound physical and mental health; and
9. be willing to accept the terms and conditions specified in the Scholarship Contract which include, among others, return service on a full time basis for a minimum period equivalent to the length of time he/she enjoyed the scholarship.

B. Documents to be submitted

- a) Accomplished Information Sheet (Form 1);
- b) Certification of Employment and Permit to Study (Form 2);
- c) Photocopy of birth certificate;

- d) Certificate of Health Status (Form 3);
- e) Certified True Copy of Service Record;
- f) Certified True Copy of Official Transcript of Records (TOR);
- g) Notice of Admission to the PhD in Science/ Mathematics Education program in any of the identified universities;
- h) Endorsement from two (2) former professors and
- i) Letter of nomination/recommendation from the head of the TEI.
